

AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION

Signed on in Cracow,

between

The University of Algarve, established at Campus of Penha in Faro, Portugal represented by its Rector, Professor Joao Pinto Guerreiro, as the 1st Granter, succinctly hereinafter referred to as UAlg

and

Tadeusz Kościuszko Cracow University of Technology, established in 24, Warszawska St., Cracow, Republic of Poland, represented by its Vice Rector, Professor Dariusz Bogdał, succinctly hereinafter referred to as CUT

Hereby declare that:

§ 1

1. UAlg and CUT express their willingness to establish cooperation aimed at:
 - cooperation in the domain of scientific research within the areas of interest common to both undersigned parties,
 - exchange of experience in the area of *curricula* improvement and the organization of the teaching process.
2. Both parties to this agreement will aim at a high level of scientific research and the free and open exchange of ideas in the fields of science located in the areas of mutual interest.

§ 2

1. The contracting parties shall implement this cooperation in the following areas:
 - exchange of experiences, scientific research and staff training,
 - cooperation in executing research programs, respecting intellectual property rights and in compliance with applicable laws,
 - undertaking joint initiatives to raise funds necessary to carry out joint research,
 - exchange experiences related to degree programs,
 - exchange of staff and students.
2. The Institutional Coordinator for International Relations and Mobility of UALG and Erasmus Coordinator at the Faculty of Civil Engineering of CUT are designated as representatives to facilitate direct contact and coordination of activities between parties to this agreement.



§ 3

1. The costs of cooperation established within the framework of this agreement shall be borne by both parties in proportion to their share.
2. Both parties agree, that the details of the cooperation shall be the subject of separate agreements governing, among others, costs and funding of joint ventures, subject to the principles laid out in paragraph 1.

§ 4

This agreement shall remain in force for a period of three years from the date of signature, with the understanding that it may be terminated by either party giving six months' notice to the other party in writing.

§ 5

This agreement of cooperation has been prepared in duplicate in English language.
