4. Termination of the agreement

*It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."*

The lowest passing grade is 10.

**ECTS credits:**

1 full academic year = 60 credits

1 semester = 30 credits

1 trimester = 20 credits

**ECTS grading scale:**

A	10	EXCELLENT - outstanding performance with only minor errors
B	25	VERY GOOD - above the average standard but with some errors

FX	-	FAIL - some work required before the criteria can be awarded
F	-	FAIL - considerable further work is required
